Parking Lot Rules at CHPS



During morning drop off (9:00 a.m. – 9:15 a.m.), for students who are being dropped off in the kiss and ride area, we are asking drivers to please <u>drive</u> <u>slowly</u> and <u>wait patiently</u> until a spot along the sidewalk becomes available for a safe drop off. When possible, move as far up along the sidewalk as space allows. If at all possible, students should exit the vehicle from the **LEFT** hand side, closest to the gate entrance. *Cars should not be left unattended or idling*,

nor should they be parked in the middle of the kiss and ride to drop off students. If you would prefer to wait and watch your child enter the building, please park your car in the lot and walk them to the gate. Please do not park in the kiss and ride lanes.

Our parking lot exit will be closed from 3:20 p.m. until 3:45 p.m. During this 25 minute time period, cars will be unable to leave the parking lot. This is to reduce traffic and to help ensure the safety of nearly 700 students being dismissed at the end of the school day. Please do not pull into or park in the lot if you need to leave before 3:45 pm. By parking on a nearby side street, and walking students to and from that spot you may actually save time by avoiding congested traffic areas.
